YOUR TASK:

Your task is to persuade a person in power like a politician or owner of a company why single-use materials should be banned. Choose one of the following tasks to complete. A few suggestions of what you could include have been listed below.

1. Write a letter to a big manufacturer or politician of your choice (for example, McDonald's or the Prime Minister)

- Keep it short and clear. Try and keep the letter under 2 sides of A4 paper
- If you are struggling, you can use the following structure:
 - Introduce the topic you will be talking about
 - Explain why you are interested in the topic and why you think it is important
 - Include questions that you want answered e.g. "What do you think about single-use plastic?"
 - Request what action you want them to take
 - Make a request that they reply to your letter

2. Prepare a speech and present it in front of your class

- Think of the language you are going to use
- How will you deliver the speech?
- Make sure all the ideas you present are backed up with relevant information or facts
